Community radio Alfaz-e-Mewat FM 107.8, an initiative of S M Sehgal Foundation, celebrated World Radio Day in varied ways. The celebrations of this special day began with a community event in village Hamjapur, district Nuh, Haryana, on Feb 12, 2021, where women achievers at the grassroots shared their journeys. Ms. Pooja O Murada represented Alfaz-e-Mewat at The Radio Festival held at India International Center on Feb 13, 2021, New Delhi, where she shared about community radios experience amid COVID times and how radio served the communities. The foundation team was also part of the webinar organized by NCERT and CIET on educational programming on radio. The Statesman featured Alfaz-e-Mewat as part of its World Radio Day story.

A community radio Alfaz-e-Mewat FM 107.8 event was part of the Sandvik project, also marking the World Radio Day on February 12, 2021, in village Hamjapur, district Nuh, Haryana. About fifty people attended, including villagers, school authorities, and School Management Committee members. The team invited three women achievers, referred to as *laados* (लाड़ो-brand ambassadors associated with the "selfie with daughter" campaign), from Nuh; Dr Ashfaq, social worker; and CDPO, Nuh, Ms. Madhu Jain.

The radio team members felicitated the invited speakers and women achievers from the village. Wrapping up the event, a team representative shared a few lines:
